

Global Entry at *McCarran* INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Global Entry is an international traveler's ticket to get out of line.

U.S. Customs and Border Protection developed this pilot program to provide a single, integrated passenger processing system that makes it easier and faster for participants to clear customs at select U.S. airports, including McCarran International. Using biometric technology, Global Entry allows those who have passed a pre-travel background check to use automated kiosks and expedited service lanes at participating customs inspection stations. While other travelers must typically wait in line to interact with a customs agent, those enrolled in Global Entry can instead use kiosks to quickly complete their re-entry process.

Those interested in Global Entry must first apply online. Once CBP has reviewed the application, eligible participants in Southern Nevada will be asked to come to McCarran's Terminal 2 to be interviewed at CBP's Enrollment Center (see map below). Applicants can use any public airport parking lot, including one located across from Terminal 2's Ticketing lobby. Standard airport parking rates will be charged.
