

INVITATION FOR QUALIFICATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Board of Clark County Commissioners, Clark County, Nevada, will receive sealed responses from interested, qualified persons or firms for the management of an Airport Billboard Advertising Agreement for Airport-owned outdoor advertising locations along the Airport Corridor and surrounding access roads at McCarran International Airport.

The responses must be time-stamped by 4:00 PM (PDT) on or before August 28, 2009. Proposal Forms time-stamped at 4:01 PM (PDT) or after may not be considered and may be returned to respondent.

All responses must be submitted in accordance with the conditions and on forms which can be obtained beginning **July 15, 2009**, at the office of Michael Oram, Airport Contract Specialist, Business & Development, Fifth Floor, North End, McCarran International Airport, Clark County Department of Aviation, P.O. All responses must be submitted to the Clark County Department of Aviation, 5th Floor Reception Area at the Airport, North end, in a sealed envelope plainly marked **“REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS: RFQ 18-09 AIRPORT BILLBOARD ADVERTISING”**, with the name and address of the respondent in the upper left-hand corner.

This Request For Qualifications (RFQ) is furnished in accordance with Nevada Revised Statute 496.090 which states: “...the governing body of any municipality may authorize it to enter into any such contracts, leases and other arrangements with any persons, as provided in this section,...upon such terms and conditions as the governing body deems proper.” The material to be supplied through this RFQ is being sought for informational purposes only and does not, in any way, constitute a “bid” and should not be construed as such. The Board of County Commissioners may or may not decide to negotiate an agreement with any of the respondents to this RFQ, at its sole discretion.
