

BRUCE'S BULLETIN

After the publication of information about the South Ramp, I have received numerous questions about the new LED lighting system.

One of our goals for the project was to procure a large area lighting system that combined safety with energy efficiency. LED lighting filled these requirements.

In recent years, high-performing and energy efficient LED lighting has gained popularity as airports look at greener, more cost efficient ways to light large areas like the South Ramp. Features of LED lighting are:

- Optimized visibility for greater safety.
- Reduced energy consumption.
- Hot restart capability restores lighting almost instantly in a power outage.
- More precise, customizable illumination than conventional lighting.
- Multi-layer uniform illumination – even if an individual light unit fails, lighting covers the whole area (at a slightly reduced level), with no unlit areas.
- Zero-percent upward light ratio ensuring no light is emitted towards the sky, and enhances air safety by reducing light pollution.



SOUTH RAMP BASED AIRCRAFT PARKING

Now that the dust has settled on the move to the new South Ramp, we are happy to offer our based customers the opportunity to move their aircraft to a different location if desired (depending on availability).

ACCESS GATE PROCEDURES NO 'PIGGYBACKING'

Please follow the rules when accessing the airfield through the perimeter gates by using your access card in the card reader. You are required to wait and watch the gate close behind you before proceeding. Do not allow others to follow you onto the airfield. Each cardholder must use the card reader prior to entering (one vehicle per card). You are not to allow others to use your card for any reason. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in access card revocation.

BASED CUSTOMERS

Each year when you renew your aircraft or vehicle insurance/ registration, change insurance carriers or coverage levels, you are required to submit this information to the airport. When changing vehicles, remove the decal and submit it to the airport. You may come to the airport and provide copies or scan and send the documents to Kristy Benavidez at kristyb@mccarran.com.

stated that the gear was down, and the controller repeated his observation. A go-around was initiated by the pilot, who then entered the VFR pattern and landed without incident. The controller's quick thinking and subsequent actions averted what could have been a serious accident.
