### VEHICLE/GROUND SUPPORT EQUIPMENT OPERATIONS

Over the last few months, we have experienced an increase in vehicle-related issues on the airfield. Please review the following reminders and ensure that you adhere to the rules and regulations when operating on the tarmac.

No person shall operate or park any vehicle on the AOA unless the vehicle is currently registered with the DOA and properly identified. All vehicles designated to operate on public streets shall be subject to the licensing requirements of the State of Nevada. Other vehicles shall meet the Safety requirements in place at the time of manufacture. All vehicles operated on the AOA between civil twilight and civil sunrise shall display headlights and taillights or a yellow beacon in a prominent position. Any person operating a vehicle on the Airport shall comply with all DOA Rules and Regulations, Operating Directives, and posted restrictions.

**Only authorized vehicles with decals are allowed on the airfield, all others are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.**

**ACCESS GATE PROCEDURES: NO "PIGGYBACKING".** – Please follow the rules when accessing the airfield through perimeter gates by using your access card in the card reader. You are required to wait and watch the gate close behind you before proceeding. Do not allow others to follow you onto the airfield. Each cardholder **MUST** use the card reader prior to entering (one vehicle per card). If you have a need to escort a vehicle onto the airfield for any reason, please contact the Customer Service Desk for assistance. Failure to follow the guidelines may result in access card revocation.

## REISSUANCE OF GATE CARDS AND VEHICLE DECALS

HND is currently in the process of issuing new vehicle decals and revalidating gate access cards. The new decals and cards carry an expiration date of June 30, 2022.



Please plan on visiting the HND Administration Office during business hours prior to February 28, 2018, as current cards and decals will not be valid as of March 01, 2018.

You must have a signed agreement with the County as a commercial operator, private hangar owner, or shade/tiedown lessee. The following documents/items must be presented in order to receive your new decal and gate card revalidation:  
Current gate card;  
Current vehicle decal (intact if possible);  
Valid copy of automobile insurance policy declarations page;  
Current copy of DMV automobile registration;  
Current copy of aircraft insurance.  
Insurance requirements are:



**Aircraft Liability Insurance:**  
Coverage for injury to persons and property damage, and such other coverage as may be necessary to protect County from such claims and actions by Tenant, either on the Airport or within the Premises. Said insurance shall have limits of not less than One Million (\$1,000,000) Dollars. Clark County must be named additional insured.

## REISSUANCE OF GATE CARDS AND VEHICLE DECALS (Cont.)

**Automobile Liability Insurance:**  
Coverage of not less than Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) combined single limits or Two Hundred Fifty Thousand/Five Hundred Thousand (\$250,000/\$500,000) Dollars per accident Bodily Injury and Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000) Property Damage. Such coverage may be maintained in the form of "excess liability coverage." Automobile liability insurance coverage does NOT require Clark County be named as an additional insured. It is required for airfield access only.
