YOUNG EAGLES

Henderson Executive Airport is sponsoring the "Young Eagles" on June 16, 2018.



Founded in 1992, the Young Eagles program has dedicated 26 years to giving youth ages 8–17 their first free ride in an airplane. It's the only program of its kind, with the sole mission to introduce and inspire kids in the world of aviation. Participants are provided with a complete briefing that includes reviewing an aeronautical chart, a careful preflight walk-around inspection of the aircraft, and a 15-20 minute flight.

A major milestone was reached recently when the 2 millionth Young Eagle was flown during AirVenture Oshkosh. As of May 21, 2018, the Young Eagles program had flown 2,091,367 kids with the help of the Experimental Aircraft Association's (EAA) network of volunteer pilots and ground volunteers.

JEAN SPORT AIRPORT RAMP EXPANSION PROJECT UPDATE

We are happy to announce that the 2.1 million dollar ramp expansion and rehabilitation project at Jean Sport Airport (0L7) is complete, and we look forward to it serving our Jean tenants and customers for years to come.

Fast Facts:

- The project was approximately 93% funded by the FAA Airport Improvement Program.
- 233,500 s.f. of new ramp space was added.
- 177,000 s.f. of existing terminal ramp space was removed and replaced.
- Brand new LED High Mast Lighting was installed, providing bright, efficient state-of-the-art lighting.
- Six new rows of aircraft parking are available in the expanded area.
- The project was divided into two main phases, and incorporated sub-phases during new pavement tie-ins.
- The phasing plan minimized runway and taxiway closures, significantly reducing impact to Jean operations.

TOWER TALK

From the Tower Manager, Jon Hanf

A friendly reminder to all pilots:

The warm (hot!) weather is rapidly approaching. Make sure to check your density altitude. If the temperature is above 85 degrees Fahrenheit, a reminder will be on the ATIS.

For pilots who are requesting flight following with RADAR, please advise the ground controller of your type aircraft, destination, and requested altitude.

NOTE: When exiting the runway, ensure that you taxi your aircraft completely past the runway HOLD BARS. Until you

are clear of the hold bar, you are technically still on the runway. Thanks to all of you and let's be safe!

REMINDER: The HND "Fly Safely and Quietly" guidance brochure is intended to be used as guidance for pilots operating when the Air Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) is closed. These procedures NEVER supersede instructions you receive from the ATCT.
