

## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO: WHICH TRAM FROM THE D GATES?

Las Vegas is arguably the most exciting city on the planet and — we get it — you can't wait to start your vacation. But don't make the common mistake of getting distracted or following the crowd when you deplane at McCarran's D gates. The airport has two terminals, both of which are reached by trams leaving from the D Concourse. If you need to claim checked bags, the terminal with your baggage claim depends on which airline you are flying.

If you arrived on a flight with **Delta** or **American**, go down the escalator and look for the signs directing you to the **TERMINAL 1 TRAM STATION**. Board the first available tram in the station to go to Terminal 1.

If you flew **Air Canada**, **Frontier**, **Hawaiian**, **Sun Country** or **United**, go down the escalator and look for the signs pointing to the **TERMINAL 3 TRAM STATION**. Board the first available tram in the station to go to Terminal 3.
